 These can come from individuals, members of the public, GPs etc.
- Through sitting with them and talking, finding out their problems and then signpost through the community and by supporting them they will gain confidence.
- Help also with filling out 'forms' maybe for benefits or financial.
- There have been 45 cases since June and 11 in the last week.
- Hyndburn Homewise could assess their home for adaptions etc.
- Volunteers are needed to talk, listen, show empathy, sympathy or to be firm where needed.
- Volunteers are co-ordinated through CVS and placements have been offered through UCLAN.
- Age UK help with bed blockers (hospitals) of the over 55s.
